

Who is the best?

You can tell from the parasitized aphid which species has been threatening your crop. It will be immediately clear which parasitic wasp is the best natural enemy for the job, and these can be deployed en masse in the right spot to ensure the most effective control of the aphids. In this way, Aphiscout helps you take control of the situation. As the parasitic wasps each have their own preferences, the initial control of the most commonly occurring aphids is also assured in your crop.

Simple and ingenious

Besides the NectarPad, the cylindrical packaging also has a unique hanging system, making it easy to position it in the crop. As the label consists of two layers, the outer adhesive film can be rolled around wires or plant stems, for example.

Nothing more is required. Aphiscout can be used for the entire crop, over a period of a number of weeks, depending on the level of infestation, climate conditions, and sensitivity

of the crop.
